## From the Manager ~

A new year is underway. I am quite certain that as it unfolds God will amaze and surprise us just as He did this past year.

As I look back over this past year I praise God for each of our faithful support partners. In a year where much news was made about financial woes, Psalm 99:5 was not only able to keep current with our accounts payable, but begin a building project for a new building for our transmitting equipment. That project has been slightly stalled by a few circumstances beyond our control but we still plan to be moved into it this spring or summer. Our support partners have provided a good portion of the financial need to finish this project and to date the construction has been debt free! We still need many thousands of dollars for this job but I know God will provide.

This past year we were also able to finish a project for the new translator in Tower, MN. We first moved to have this project built nearly ten years ago. Government delays held this project up for many years but we were able to build it and turn it on near the end of 2009. This project was also completed debt free! Most of the parts for this

project had been purchased years ago and we were able to 're-purpose' some others to this facility. It is 'on-the-air' and working very well, providing a great signal to a largely under-served area.

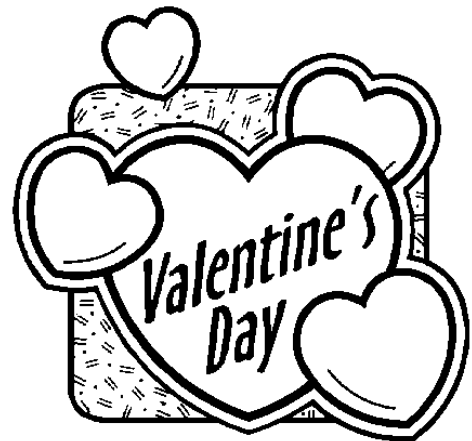

## Worship Review

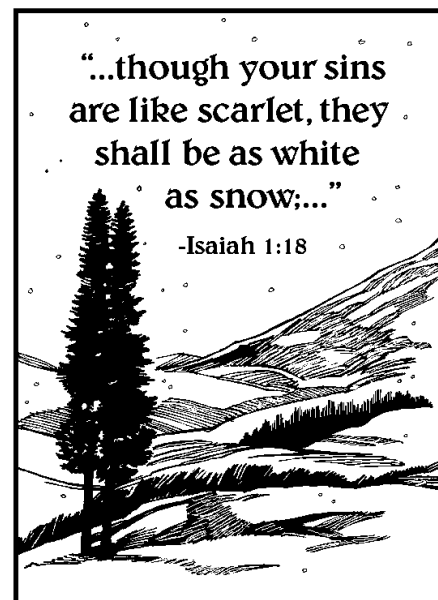
